## 8 Under-the-Radar Lunch Deals in Atlanta

Lunchtime provides a great opportunity to dine at some of the city's top restaurants without busting your budget. Many restaurants also use lunchtime to experiment with menu items and play with more casual classics like sandwiches and salads. You'll also find plenty of daytime-only menu items, special packaged deals and other incentives. Dig in to these dishes for a midday meal that satisfies — and then, yes, come back for dinner.



## Cook Hall

The menu at this gastropub, located within the **W Buckhead** hotel, focuses on shareable small plates. Look into its weekday "Lunch Box" option though, for a prix fixe option that gives you a chance to taste a number of Cook Hall's dishes. It's also guaranteed to all come out in 30 minutes, so if you're taking a break from work you'll be able to make that meeting.

**The Deal:** The Lunch Box comes in either two- or three-course options (\$12 and \$16, respectively). Starting snacks can include deviled eggs or a salad, followed by tomato soup or popcorn shrimp with a ranch dressing, for instance (note that the menu does change depending on seasonality). Cook Hall's pulled-pork sliders or a black-truffle grilled cheese sandwich round things out, and if dessert's in the cards, a sweet butterscotch pudding or cinnamon doughnuts should tide you over for the rest of the work day.

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
